

Student Sponsorship Policy

PURPOSE

Leopold Primary School student sponsorship for events program enables students to further their skills in a non-school setting. This may include State, National and International events.

SCOPE

To assist students with expenses incurred when they excel in various activities.

- To reinforce, complement and extend learning opportunities beyond the classroom
- To develop an understanding that learning is not limited to school, and that valuable and powerful learning takes place in places other than at school.

POLICY

State \$50.00 (approximately – dependant on needs / expenses incurred)

National \$150.00 (approximately - dependant on needs / expenses incurred)

• International \$200.00 (approximately – dependant on needs / expenses incurred)

- Students will be required to provide a report to School Council after the sponsored event
- Sponsorship may be in the form of cash, targeted expenses, vouchers or goods, at the discretion of School Council
- Teams will be considered as a group application
- Submissions to be forwarded to School Council within four weeks of the event
- Funding may only be accessed once at each level (State, National, International) per student, per annum
- Each case will be considered on an individual basis and will be at the discretion of the School Council
- Locally raised school funds will be used to fund sponsorship
