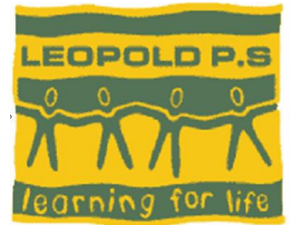

LEOPOLD PRIMARY SCHOOL HOUSE CROSS COUNTRY SPORTS

We are delighted to be able to run our Whole School Cross Country sports on Tuesday 20th April. (First Tuesday in Term 2). This event will involve all students from Prep- Grade 6 and we encourage all students to wear their house colours on the day.

Location: Leopold Primary School Athletics Track (On Vicarage Rd side of the school)

Time: 11:30am-1:30pm

Arrangement:

Students: Will be sitting with their house groups and teachers in the middle of the synthetic oval

Parents: will be asked to sit or stand near the Bellarine building and adjacent open space.

Races: Order of Events

1st event: Year 2 Fun Run ~400m

2nd Event: 9/10 Year old races, ~1.1KM, boys will start 1min prior to the girls

3rd Event: Prep Fun Run~400m

4th Event: 11 Year old races, ~2.2KM, boys will start 1min prior to the girls

5th Event: Year 1 Fun Run ~400m

6th Event: 12/13 year old races ~2.2KM, boys will start 1min prior to the girls

Note: Student age groups determined by year of birth eg all students born in 2010 will be in the 11 years group

District Qualification:

In the three older age groups, the top 8 boys and girls in each race will qualify for the Connewarre District Cross Country Event.
